

Cornice Nr. 110 “Derby Ogee”



Yet another “average sized” cornice design.

Consider using this one in areas with low(Ish) ceilings or complex ceiling plans.

It is simple, clean and a relatively modern design - please consider this for your next project?

It may be possible to use this inverted or the other way up. However I honestly believe this (as illustrated is the best / preferred way) for this design of cornice.

If you're considering using this as part of a “self install” project, this might be suitable - but please note the thin edges and in any case refer to;-

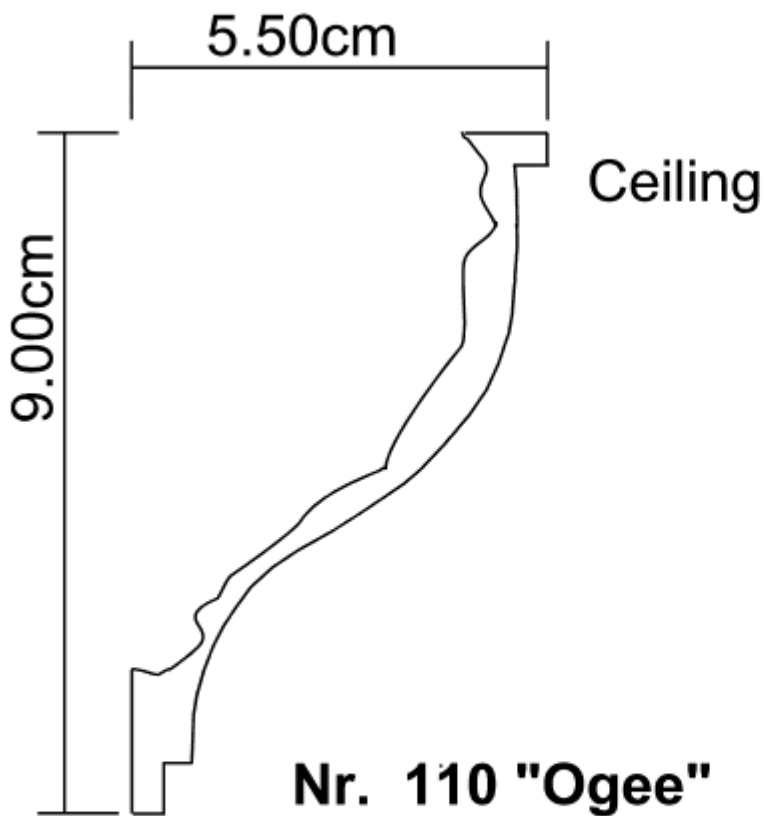
