

Cornice Nr. 123 “Clothiers” (Victorian in Style)



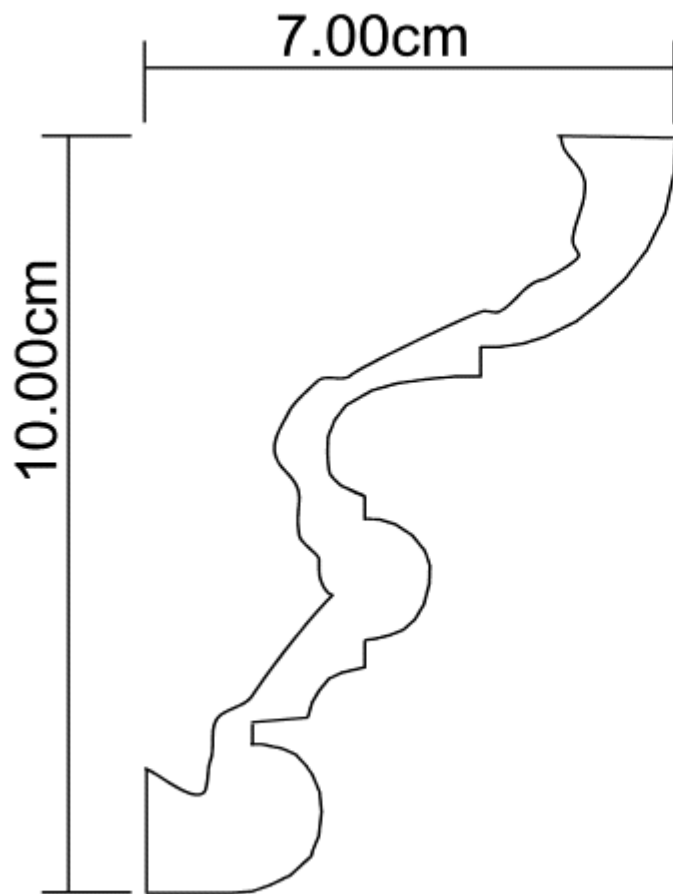

Yes, this was made for Main Street in Parc EuroDisney (or whatever name it now is in this year’s “rebranding”. But never mind all that, this remains a nice, detailed cornice with more than a bit of style - to my view. I’d certainly install it in my own home.
