

Cornice Nr. 140 “Helmond”



This is a good big cornice design. A pattern that was originally designed for a newly built five star hotel in Leeds. While this was built several years ago, I believe the Marriott remains the sole such hotel in that city.

It is, to me vaguely Victorian in design, but in truth that is possibly not so, but to me this impression remains.

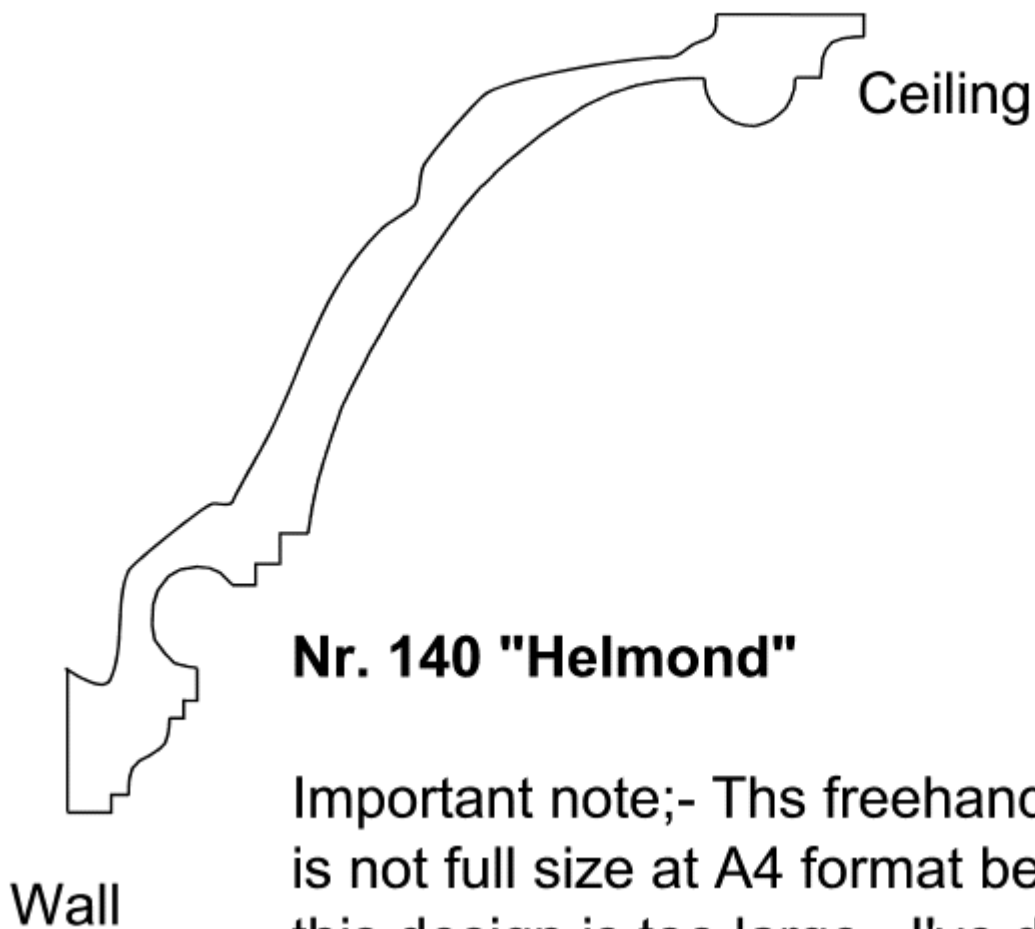
I cannot recommend that this complex profile is at all suitable for DIY installation - unless you are accomplished and patient. Mitres are also awkward to fill. Please see the cross section on page two - this document.

Projection 210mm. (c.10.5”)

Depth 205mm. (c.8”)

Length of Cast 3200mm. (10’6”)

Important note;- This freehand sketch is not full size at A4 format because this design is too large. I've drawn it out at half full size. Therefore I suppose it might be approximately correct if printed to A3 format.

This cornice projects roughly 205mm. from the wall, it is 210mm. deep from the ceiling.
