

Cornice Nr. 153 “Large Rope”



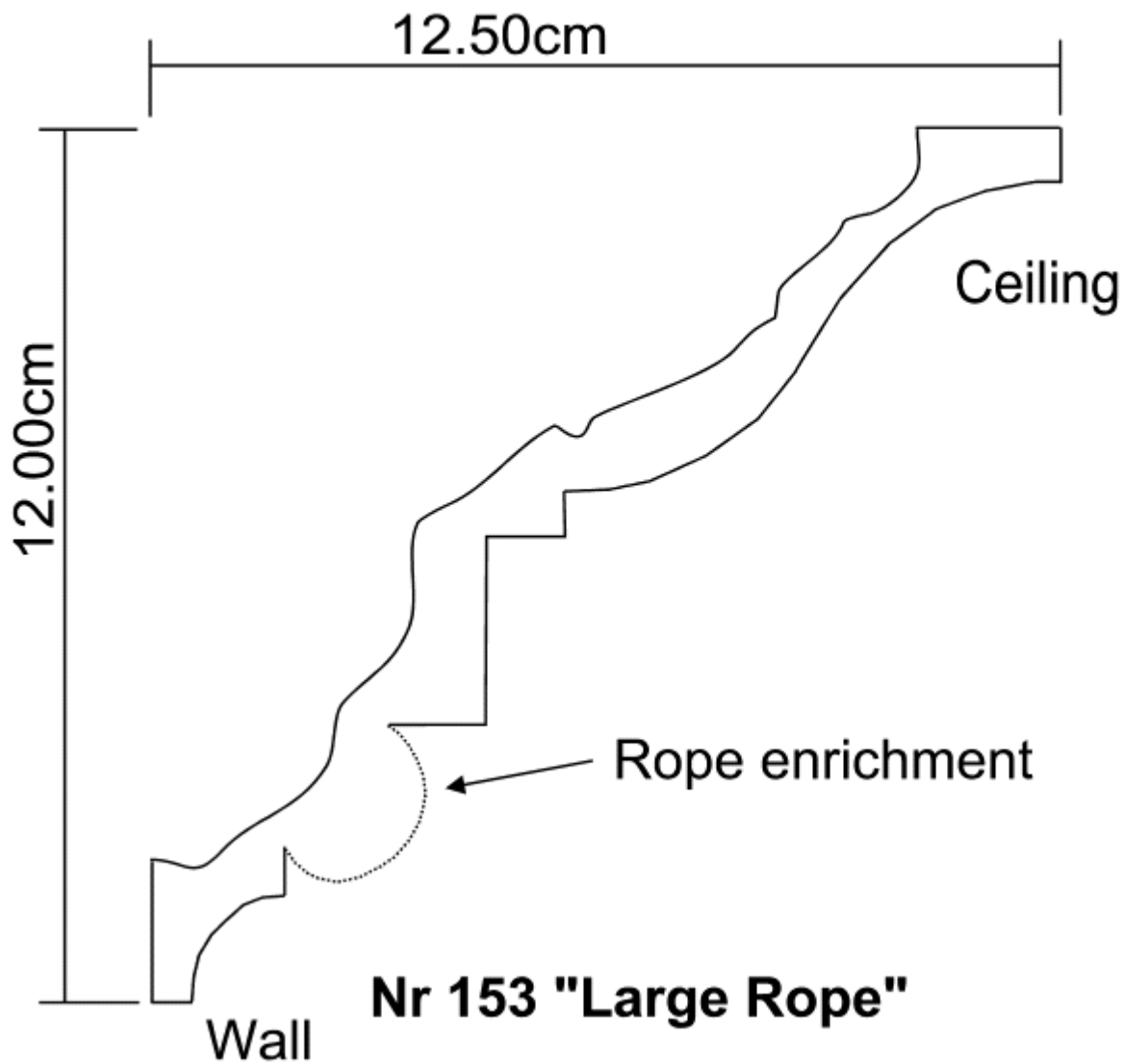
This cornice, while quite a nice design, is not actually from / of any historical period.

It is simply a reasonably clean, “average sized” rope enriched pattern. There is also a smaller, similar cornice - Nr. 144 “Small Rope”.

It is probably quite suitable for the “amateur” or DIY installer, but do please have a good careful read of our DIY page on this web site first - it is actually a very helpful, practical and useful document.
